Dear Parents/Carers,

Remote Learning Provision

I wanted to update you on the work that has taken place in school in preparation for the remote learning of your child as we are now in the position of having the whole school closure of Wraxall CofE Primary due to the Pandemic. We want to ensure that your children are in the best possible position to continue with their learning. We have adapted our provision from the last lockdown and developed further interaction and learning opportunities for the children.

I have attached documentation that includes the following;

- **A Timetable** to share the structure of the day and which parts are live interactions (including group meetings, reading opportunities, SEN support etc.), when teachers will be responding to emails and providing feedback to submitted work and when pre-recorded lessons will be available from.

- **How to** use MS Teams instructions.

All children, were given their MS Teams log-in details last year and I know that you were all busy using these in the previous lockdown. Reception families and new starters received their details before Christmas. We did ask all families to log in to check that these were working and the office have worked hard to rectify any issues that they were informed of.

We have planned to pre-record much of the content to ensure that children can access the learning when they are able to. If you face difficulties accessing technology then please contact school as we may be able to support you with this.

We thank you in advance for supporting your child in using MS Teams to ensure the best possible provision for them in unprecedented times. In these uncertain times we wanted to share with you what remote learning will look like. Thank you for the compassion that you continue to demonstrate. It is always appreciated and is what helps to make Wraxall such a special place.
