Here are your spellings for the term. Please keep this list at home; don't stick it in your homework book. We will have copies in the classroom for practicing at school.

Every week we will have 16 spellings. This term we are revising five groups of words with a focus on their patterns, which we will learn in school. Our tests are on Fridays and your target is to get at least $\frac{3}{4}$ of them correct (12 out of 16); there will be a retest the following week for everyone who does not achieve this.

Parents / carers – if you feel that your child needs a shorter list, please discuss this with Mr Khanna; their words are the first eight.

Challenge – there will also be four bonus unseen words every week, which will follow that week's spelling pattern. They do not count for the 12/16 target, but are worth an extra work mark if all correct.
