


DON'T WEAR Jeans or jewellery and avoid wearing cotton if possible.

Last Chance to apply for 2024 Primary School Places

Do you have a child due to start school (Reception) or transfer to a junior school in September 2024? Have you applied for their place yet?

Applications for primary school places must be submitted before next Monday the 15th January. This applies to all children starting school for the first time in September 2024 (those born between 1st September 2012 and 31st August 2020), as well as children moving from infant to junior school (even if they are already attending an infant school connected to or on the same site as a junior school).
