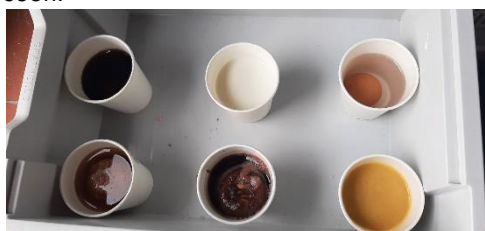
This Week
